Project Description	The background in Nottinghamshire was that the politicians felt they weren't customer responsive enough and took too long to get programmes of work on the ground. Savings were also needed across the organisation so a LEAN approach was taken across the whole of the Council, and the Highway Service was part of this. Nottinghamshire used external consultants to support the work initially and to train people to continue the LEAN work.
	largest volume of demand and they wanted to create a new customer service attitude amongst their staff. They included highway management, the inspection service, district managers, and their customer interface through the call centre, network management, co- ordination of roadworks, forestry and civil parking enforcement.
Outcomes and benefits	They have dramatically changed their philosophy, modernised the attitude of staff and changed their culture. The LEAN process prepared them for the future in light of increased expectations and reduced budgets. They have saved money and improved their service.
